Electric cars are becoming popular, now that the world is focusing more on minimising climate change. Electric cars don't create any emissions when they are driven, meaning that they improve air quality. The UK wants road transport to create zero carbon emissions by 2050, so, starting 2030, the sale of new nonelectric cars will be banned.

Traditional cars run off petrol or diesel, but electric cars require charging points to recharge the cars' batteries. However, although the number of **accessible** charging points has increased in the past few years, there continues to be a serious lack of them on some roads. Consequently, drivers have to carefully plan their journeys, especially as you can't travel as far between charges as you can when

refuelling a traditional car. Furthermore, it takes longer to charge an electric car than to top up with petrol.

Another problem is that they cost around £8,000 more than a regular car. Some governments are providing financial support for people who buy new electric cars. These grants pay a small percentage of the car's price, in addition to covering the cost of a home charging point.

One reason for their high price is that the batteries are produced from materials that have to be mined from the ground. Therefore, there is only a limited amount of them. So, although electric cars will help make our roads ecofriendly, governments are going to have to invest a lot in order to make them affordable for everyone.
